Lesson 1, To explore composition and identify the key features of a landscape

Key assessment questions:

- Can children cut out complex shapes using scissors safely and carefully?
- Can children draw lines to represent the horizon line and the sea?
- Can children compose a beach scene using shapes provided and their imagination?

Lesson 2, To explore different textures

Key assessment questions:

- Can children identify different textures in a scene?
- Can children find appropriate materials to create different textures and apply appropriate textures to a well-known painting?

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Lesson 3, To Paint using different tints and shades

Key assessment questions:

- Can children create different tints and shades?
- Can children use different tints and shades to create a tonal representation of the sea and sky?
- Can children understand that light colours stand out more and darker colours recede (move backwards)?

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Lesson 4, To reproduce and apply an artist's colour range to their own work

Key assessment questions:

- Can children identify colours used in artist's works?
- Can children mix colours to match those they have seen?
- Can children apply the colours carefully with a paintbrush?

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<u>Lesson 5, To create details using controlled painting and other materials and objects</u> <u>Key assessment questions:</u>

- Can children paint areas of dark and light?
- Can children use a small brush to paint details?
- Can children use other objects and materials to add further details?

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
