| Key Vocabulary |  |

| Composition | Putting different elements together in a <br> pleasing way. |
| Hue | Describing an exact colour: sky blue, <br> dark green, rose pink. |
| Proportion | How big a part of something looks <br> compared to the rest of it. |
| Shade | Adding black to a colour makes a shade. |
| Shadow | A dark area created when light is <br> blocked. |
| Still life | An artwork showing a collection of things <br> that don't move, e.g. objects rather than <br> people. |
| Tint | Adding white to a colour makes a tint. |
| Tone | How light or dark a colour is. |
