## Music Knowledge Organiser

Key Vocabulary	
<b>Time Signature</b>	Shows the number of beats in the bar.
<b>Bar line</b>	Divides the music into units of time.
<b>Metallophone</b>	Percussion instruments consisting of a series of metal bars that make tines when struck.
<b>Rest</b>	A silence.
<b>Ostinato</b>	A repeating pattern of notes.
<b>Harmony</b>	Two or more notes that sound good when played at the same time.
<b>Dynamics</b>	The volume of the music
