Key Vocabulary	
<b>Jesus</b>	Christians believe Jesus was the son of God, whose teachings were used as the basis of Christianity.
<b>Serve</b>	To support and help others.
<b>Vocation</b>	The job someone holds
<b>Church</b>	A public building for Christian worship. The names vicar, priest and rector are all used to give names to the people who lead worship in church.
<b>Beliefs</b>	Something someone accepts as true or real; a firmly held opinion.
<b>Faith</b>	Trusting in something or someone.
<b>Compassion</b>	To recognise the suffering of others and take action to help
